

Warangal student bags Rs 1.2 crore package with Google

According to the placement report released by the IIT-H during the last May, as many as 268 students of the 2017-18 academic year were placed out of 424 registered for placements this year.

Sangareddy: Kudugunta Sneha Reddy from Warangal, who graduated from IIT-Hyderabad this year has bagged a whopping Rs 1.2 crore pay package per annum from Google, the highest received by a student in IIT-H's history since it was established in 2008. Sneha Reddy, 22, a Computer Science Graduate, has also bagged one of the four gold medals given away by the Institute on the eve of VIIth Convocation held on Sunday. She received the medal under 'Excellence in Academics and Co-curricular activities', from President of India, Ram Nath Kovind. She was also conferred with convocation Certificate by the Institute. Director of IIT-H, Prof UB Desai and faculty were all praise for the student, who made IIT-H proud. Sudhakar, Sneha's father, works in a software firm in Hyderabad. Surprisingly, the topper of her batch, Ibrahim Dalal has bagged Rs 35 lakh per annum package. Dalal too has received the medal for scoring best CGPA this year. According to the placement report released by the IIT-H during the last May, as many as 268 students of the 2017-18 academic year were placed out of 424 registered for placements this year. The highest package was offered to a student until May was Rs 40 lakh and the average

package was put at Rs 11.5 lakh. However, a good number of students have also bagged the offers from Multinational Companies during June and July months. The IIT-H is expected to release an updated report on placements this year shortly.
