Sangareddy: Indian Institute of Technology-Hyderabad (IIT-H) renamed all its hostel buildings after 10 ancient Indian scientists and experts. The hostel buildings, which were earlier called A, B, C, D, E, G, H, I, J and P, are now renamed after ancient scientists who made significant contribution to the field of science. IIT-H named them after Aryabhata, Bhaskaracharya, Susruta, Kautilya, Vyas, Brahmagupta, Varhamihira, Maitreyi, Gargi and Kapila.
